



## 2020 OPENING PLAN FOR MADISON INTERNATIONAL AND ANGELL PARK SPEEDWAYS

Both auto racing facilities are located in Dane County, Wisconsin and are currently limited to 100 attendees during Phase 2 of the Public Health of Madison and Dane County 'Dane Forward' Order. During Phase 3, these speedways would be limited to 250 attendees under their current category of Outdoor Mass Gatherings. Both speedways have asked to be recognized as Places of Outdoor Amusement and Activity, the same category assigned to the state owned Milwaukee Mile at Wisconsin State Fair Park. While businesses such as indoor trampoline parks and zoos are allowed to open in Dane County at 50% in Phase 2, outdoor facilities such as these two community involved speedways remain closed. Below is a list of just some of the steps these tracks are prepared to institute as necessary once they are rightfully allowed to open alongside the countless racing and outdoor amusement facilities that have already successfully opened throughout the state.

### In the Competitor Area

- Competitors are limited to 10 people total per team.
- Teams to stay in their own pit area.
- 6' Distance to be adhered to in sitting/standing viewing areas.
- Drivers meeting will be via public address system, there will be no gathering in pit area.
- Anyone experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 will not be allowed to attend.
- All team members must agree in writing that they will adhere to all policies and restrictions prior to entering the restricted area and will be encouraged to wear face coverings

### In the Main Seating Area

- We are prepared to have ushers help direct groups to open areas to ensure distancing in grandstands, forming family seating arrangements of 2-4-6 with 6 feet of spacing between seating groups, utilizing measurement tools as needed.
- All concession stands will be equipped with plexi glass to separate attendees from staff and/or service staff will wear face coverings
- Concession lines will be limited to one person per group, queuing areas will also be clearly marked with distancing markings
- Hand Sanitizer will be available throughout the facility at key locations including gates and concession areas
- Two employees will be responsible for monitoring and disinfecting high touch areas as well as rest rooms during each event.
- Use of face coverings highly encouraged
- Anyone experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 will not be allowed to attend.
