Pit Pass Price: \$30. There is NO car entry fee for this event. Minimum Pit Age: No minimum, under 18 must have properly completed Minor's Release on File - LINK

Qualifying Procedures: Each car will be given two (2) qualifying laps with the best lap establishing their qualifying time. CARS OUT OF ORDER MAY BE PENALIZED ONE LAP OF QUALIFYING. The top 18 qualifiers will be locked into features (Dice roll plus 6 with previous feature winner starting behind invert and NOT figured into invert). Remainder of cars will be split into one or two Last Chance qualifying races straight up from qualifying with a total of four (4) cars transferring into feature to fill positions 19-22. If 28 or less cars, all cars will start features with no last chance.



Provisional Starting Positions: In order to be eligible for provisional starting position, car must be deemed to make every attempt to transfer by traditional means. Position 23, 25 highest in 2025 MIS Late Model Points (Top 25), Position 24 highest in 2025 neighboring track or Big 8 points (Top 10). When no eligible cars are available for a Provisional prior to Last Chance event, additional transfer(s) will be awarded from Last Chance event to fill field at tail of field. If no eligible cars are available for a Provisional following Last Chance event, fastest nontransferring car from qualifying will fill Provisional at tail of field.

Second Feature: Feature One finish will be inverted by dice roll plus 6 with Feature One winner starting behind invert and NOT figured into invert. Management reserves the right to add additional cars to either feature to fill the field.

Feature Event: Madison Speedway Late Model Points paying events. Twin 38 lap feature events, not counting yellow flag laps. Choose cone will be used in second half of feature(s) only. MUST stay in lane until the green flag is displayed and through the exit of turn 2. Single file starts may start racing at start finish line. Two spot penalty per infraction.

Last Chance 12 laps: 1-4. Transfer, ROF/Min \$200

All cars transferring from Last Chance event or Provisional will forfeit Last Chance awards.

Tires: This event will utilize the Hoosier D-800 only. TEAMS COMPETING WEEKLY AT MIS, tires used in competition must be from those within your tire bank.

Visiting Cars: If you have not run at MIS in 2025, you will be allowed one new tire, two (2) tires measuring 4/32 and one (1) tire measuring 5/32 depth. These tires will then establish your bank.

Chemical treatment (softening) is not allowed.
