Cone: The Cone will only be used for the second half of a feature, will not be used in heats. All choose except for those involved, pitted or lapped (tail of longest).

No Move Rule: As a reminder, we have a 30 minute no move rule after the races.

Payoff: Payoff will take place following the race program at the pit gate. In order to be paid you must have a Registration on file. Midwest Dash will handle their payout tonight.

Scoring.racing: We will have line-ups posted here tonight

Line-ups Hobby, Bandits: We will invert all races by 75% of the field, heats will be split Fast/Slow

Time Limit: Each race will have a time limit of one minute per lap, at official's discretion, typically the next flag flown after the time limit is reached will be a checkered with or without a yellow flag

Pit Parking: Stalls with a cone are reserved, rest are first come first served.

6shooter Raceceivers: All 6shooters will be provided with a Raceceiver Rental at no charge, just bring your ID to the pit gate. Bring your own ear buds or you can purchase buds for \$1 a pair.
